Drawing on an international author and editor community, the AUC Press publishes—in both digital and print formats—reviewed scholarly books, fiction (through a separate imprint hoopoefiction.com), Arabic teaching books, Egypt-focused books, and general interest publications. The Press currently produces up to 50 new books each year, and maintains a backlist of some 800 titles mainly for distribution worldwide through Ingram Content Group (North America) and Ingram Publisher Services UK (rest of world, excluding North America). It also operates two bookstores in Cairo, including a flagship store in Tahrir Square.

For more than 60 years, the AUC Press has remained committed to advancing a deeper knowledge and understanding of the history, peoples, and cultures of the Middle East by publishing high-quality scholarly and general interest books on the region for a global readership.

All scholarly manuscripts are subjected to rigorous peer review to ensure the highest academic standards. Through our exacting editorial work, intimate knowledge of the region, and familiarity with local languages, we bring a wealth of expertise to all our publications while providing a close personalized service for our authors.

Our international audience of readers is reached through an extensive network of distributors, representatives, and bookstores. With warehouses in Egypt, the USA, and the UK, and the facility to print in four continents, we have presence in all our key markets.

AUC Press promotes its books in multiple ways—by sending out review copies to cultural and literary media; sending out targeted e-mailings to customers, specialized bookshops, and to academics and librarians; distributing flyers and display copies at conferences, exhibitions, and meetings; disseminating digital content on AUC Press books through an active and engaged social media presence; and through attendance of academic conferences and international bookfairs such as the Frankfurt and London bookfairs.

The Press has experience in collaborations with museum shops and independent bookstores and can provide logistical support for book launches or other promotional events.
